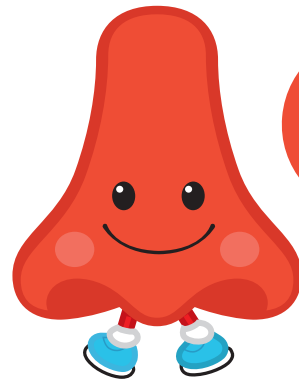




Senses

Normans' Activity



Adult supervision required

Scented paint

You will need:

- 5 postcard-sized pieces of card
- 5 different coloured paints
- 5 different scented oils or Kool-Aid sachets

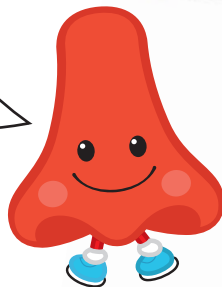
Questions to ask:

- What can they smell?
- Do they like the smell?
- Why do they like / dislike the smell?
- What does the smell make them think of?
- What is their favourite smell? Why?

What to do:

- Put each colour paint into a separate pot
- Add a different scented oil or Kool-Aid sachet to each pot
- Stir each pot very well
- Write one colour and its smell on the back of each card
- Paint each card with the corresponding colour and scent
- Let them dry
- Once dry, give the cards to the children and ask them to rub or scratch the card before smelling it. (Do not let them try to taste the cards!)

Tip - when choosing scented oils or Kool-Aid sachets, go for strong smells, like peppermint or citrus.
