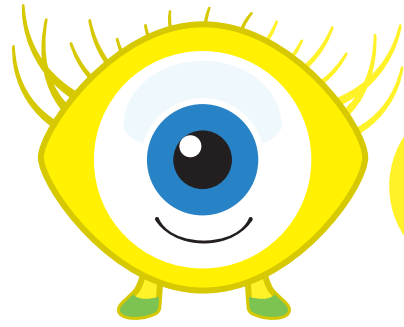

Adult supervision required

Things I See

You will need:

- A selection of magazines / brochures / leaflets
- Pictures (or print outs) of your house / family / garden etc
- A selection of different coloured cellophane sheets
- Crayons
- Paper

What to do:

- Ask the children to make a collage of things that they see in their day. Alternatively, ask them about their favourite holiday / place they've visited etc and ask them to create a collage of the things they saw there
- This can be a group activity or completed individually

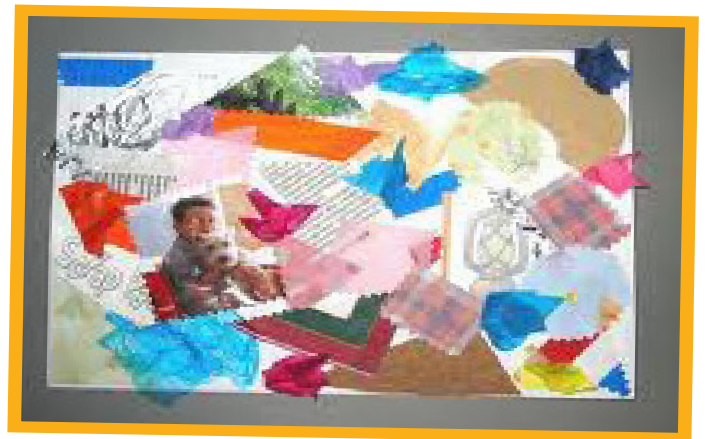
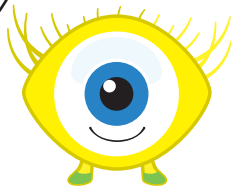
Once the collage is complete, ask them these questions:

- What is their favourite thing they can see in their collage?
- What colours can they see in their collage?
- Do they know what colour eyes they have?

To extend the activity:

- Ask them can they see a ... and pick an object from the collage
- You can also play 'I Spy' using their collages as a focus for the game

Now for my favourite bit! Ask the children to look at their collage through different coloured cellophane sheets - how does it change what they are seeing?
